New Courses

KNR 430 **The Sport Industry (3 hrs)**

Introduction to the sport industry with an emphasis on management principles and governance issues within sport organizations.

KNR 453 **Facility and Event Management in Sport and Recreation (3 hrs)**

Examination of practices in planning, designing, and operating facilities and events in sport and recreation.

KNR 463 **Advanced Sport Event Management (3 hrs)**

Application of sport management and marketing principles to field experience settings as students develop, plan, execute, and evaluate sport events. Prerequisite: KNR 453

SWK 441 **Advanced Standing Transition (3 hrs)**

Critical review of assessment, case planning, ethics, theories, practice models, social policies, evaluation.
