1. **Approval of Minutes**

Minutes of the October 26, 2006 meeting: Bantham moved the minutes be approved; McLaughlin-Gray seconded. The minutes were approved as submitted.

2. **Proposal (07.06) – Change in requirements for M.A., M.S. in Clinical-Counseling Psychology (PSY).** This is a proposal to allow students to take course PSY 490, Clinical Competency Project, to fulfill the clinical competency project option and to also add the requirement of three hours of elective credit to the clinical competency project option. (Approved in 2005, students may complete a clinical competency project to fulfill the comprehensive examination option.) Bantham moved the proposal be approved; McLaughlin-Gray seconded. The proposal was approved pending approval of new course PSY 490.

3. **Proposal (07.09) – Change in requirements for M.A., M.S. in Sociology (SOA).** This is a proposal to add to the requirements for the degree new course SOA 493.01, changing the minimum number of hours required for the degree from 37 to 38 hours. Gyires moved the proposal be approved; Bantham seconded. The proposal was approved.

4. **Proposal (07.07) – Change in requirements for the Telecommunications Sequence (M.S. in Information Systems).** This is a proposal to add to modify the requirements for the sequence to include new courses ITK 371.05, 479, and 487. Bantham moved the proposal be approved; McLaughlin-Gray seconded. The proposal was approved.

**Proposal (07.08) – Change in requirements for Systems Development Sequence (M.S. in Information Systems).** This is a proposal to modify the requirements for the sequence to include new course ITK 496. Bantham moved the proposal be approved; McLaughlin-Gray seconded. The proposal was approved pending approval of new course ITK 496.

5. **Proposal (07.10) – Information Assurance and Security Sequence (M.S. in Information Systems) – New.** This is a proposal to establish a new sequence Information Assurance and Security in the M.S. in Information Systems degree program. McLaughlin-Gray moved the proposal be approved; Bantham seconded. The proposal was approved pending completion of circulation and approval of new courses.

6. **Proposal (07.13) – Internet Applications Development Sequence (M.S. in Information Systems) – New.** This is a proposal to establish new sequence Internet Applications Development in the M.S. in Information Systems degree program. Bantham moved the proposal be approved; McLaughlin-Gray seconded. The proposal was approved pending completion of circulation and approval of new courses.

7. **Proposal (07.11) – Biomathematics Sequence (M.S. in Biological Sciences) – New.**  
This is a proposal to establish new sequence Biomathematics in the M.S. in Biological Sciences program. Gyires moved the proposal be approved; McLaughlin-Gray seconded. The proposal was approved pending completion of circulation.
8. **Proposal (07.12) – Molecular and Cellular Biology Sequence (Ph.D. in Biological Sciences) – New.** This is a proposal to establish a new sequence Molecular and Cellular Biology in the Ph.D. in Biological Sciences program. Bantham moved the proposal be approved; Gyires seconded. The proposal was approved pending completion of circulation.

ART 405 CHILDRENS ARTISTIC DEVELOPMENT (3 hrs.)  
Historical and contemporary perspectives on children's artistic development, emphasizing children's artistic, intellectual, cultural, and aesthetic sensibilities. Prerequisite: PSY 110 or 111 or equivalent, or consent of instructor.

#### **Cross-listed course in School of Art and School of Music:**

ART/MUS 428 INTEGRATING THE ARTS ACROSS THE ELEMENTARY & MIDDLE LEVEL CURRICULUM (3 hrs.)

Theoretical, practical, and experiential learning for integrating the arts across the elementary and middle school curriculum. Prerequisite: Graduate standing in Art Education or Music Education, or consent of instructor. Materials charge optional.

C&I 440 MANAGEMENT OF SCHOOL LIBRARY MEDIA PROGRAMS (3 hrs.)  
Administration and leadership of school libraries including planning for integration into the curriculum, supervision, assessment, budgeting, collaboration with administrators and teachers. Prerequisite: Certified teacher or consent of instructor.

C&I 442 ORGANIZATION AND ACCESS TO INFORMATION IN THE SCHOOL LIBRARY (3 hrs.)  
Organizing and making information accessible through classification, technology, knowledge of legal and professional guidelines, facilities planning, and policy formation. Prerequisite: Certified teacher or consent of instructor.

C&I 444 REFERENCE AND INFORMATION SERVICES (3 hrs.)  
Provision of assistance in finding, evaluating, and using information, with emphasis on the knowledge and use of print and online reference sources. Prerequisite: Certified teacher or consent of instructor.

C&I 449 SELECTION AND USE OF MATERIALS IN THE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL LIBRARY (3 hrs.)  
Collection development of print and nonprint materials grades K-8. Emphasis on age-appropriate materials supporting school curriculum and student learning. Prerequisite: Certified teacher or consent of instructor.

C&I 454 SELECTION AND USE OF MATERIALS IN THE SECONDARY SCHOOL LIBRARY (3 hrs.)  
Collection development of print and nonprint materials grades 6-12. Emphasis on age-appropriate materials supporting school curriculum and student learning. Prerequisite: Certified teacher or consent of instructor.
